- ◆ Early 2012: Meeting was held with the goal to be 1:1 in 4th-6th grades.
- ◆ Jan. 2012: Decision was made to purchase teacher iPads for applicants.
- ◆ Feb. 2012: Tech Committee drafts
 BYOD policy

Timeline (cont.)

- March 2012: Teacher iPads were deployed
- March 2012: Bristow BYOD Policy becomes SBDM-approved
- March-May 2012: Principal, SML/STC and Teachers started communicating the plan

Timeline (cont.)

- May 2012: Teachers receive Apple iPad
 Professional Development
- ◆ June 2012: Additional iPad PD Offered
- ◆ August 2012: Bristow Tech Night with parent Q&A

Timeline (cont.)

- September 2012: 4th-6th grade students began utilizing their devices in the classroom.
- ◆ January 2013: K-3 implementation by teachers that chose to implement.
